



New Jersey Immunization Information System (NJIS) Keep Track of Your Vaccines!

What is NJIS?

A free, confidential, tracking system that collects vaccination data for New Jersey residents. The NJIS combines vaccination information from all your healthcare providers into one record. It provides current recommended vaccine schedules from birth through adulthood. NJIS is managed by the Department of Health's Vaccine Preventable Disease Program to help assess statewide vaccination coverage.

How do I participate in NJIS?

Governor Murphy signed Executive Order (EO 207) to change NJIS from an **opt-in** to an **opt-out** system. If you choose to receive the COVID-19 vaccine, your doses will be automatically entered into NJIS. **This does NOT require or mandate anyone to receive the COVID-19 vaccine**

Why the change?

Previously, those born before January 1, 1998, had to opt-in to NJIS by submitting paperwork. During the pandemic, having an opt-in process would limit the ability of the state to quickly and effectively track vaccination uptake which is critical to the COVID-19 response.

Will I be able to opt-out of NJIS?

Yes, 30 days after the end of this pandemic, you will be able to opt-out from NJIS by completing a "Registrant Withdrawal from NJIS" form available at <https://www.state.nj.us/health/forms/imm-47.pdf>

Who can access my information?

Only authorized users of NJIS who signed a confidentiality agreement can access information on the registry. This includes

- Your healthcare providers
- Local and state health departments
- Licensed childcare centers, schools, or college health nurses
- Your health insurance plans



Why is this important?

Automatic enrollment in the NJIS for individuals receiving a COVID-19 vaccine will

- Help NJ track the number of COVID-19 vaccines given in NJ.
- Allow you and your provider to identify which vaccine brand you received and the appropriate timing of a second dose, if necessary.
